

Cyber Grand Challenge Non-Disclosure Agreement

BACKGROUND

The Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) intends to conduct Cyber Grand Challenge (CGC) events during 2015 and 2016. U.S. Government employees will be assisted by contractors, consultants, and others in the planning, preparation, and execution thereof from approximately June 1, 2013 to September 30, 2016. Information regarding these events is strictly confidential and may not be released without authorization by DARPA.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to ensure the proper handling of information during the planning, preparation, and execution of the Cyber Grand Challenge. This Agreement is to be broadly construed to effectuate its purpose. In addition to complying with the express terms of this agreement, all recipients of Cyber Grand Challenge Sensitive Information and Proprietary Information of Cyber Grand Challenge participants will take any additional reasonable measures to safeguard such information.

APPLICABILITY

The restrictions in this Agreement apply to individuals, companies and organizations involved in the planning, preparation, and execution of the Cyber Grand Challenge who receive or gain access to Cyber Grand Challenge Sensitive Information/Proprietary Information (Recipients). This Agreement will remain in effect whether the contract, support or assistance related to it is terminated prior to the conclusion of the Cyber Grand Challenge program.

RESTRICTIONS

Recipient agrees as follows:

Protection of Cyber Grand Challenge Sensitive Information

Recipient shall protect information regarding the Cyber Grand Challenge program that has not been released for public disclosure from deliberate or inadvertent disclosure to anyone who is not specifically designated by DARPA to receive this information. Sensitive information includes any data about the Cyber Grand Challenge program, any information that is marked For Official Use Only or Source Selection Sensitive, or any information that would give a competitive advantage to a participating team. This restriction will remain in effect until DARPA releases the information to the public. Any questions regarding whether information is subject to this clause shall be referred to the Cyber Grand Challenge Program Manager.

Protection of Proprietary Information

Recipients who have access to proprietary information regarding contractors or other organizations (including, but not limited to Cyber Grand Challenge competitors, sponsor organizations, non-government contractors, and Government support contractors) obtained as a result of duties involved in supporting the Cyber Grand Challenge shall protect this information from deliberate or inadvertent disclosure to anyone who is not specifically authorized by DARPA to receive this information. Questions regarding whether information is proprietary shall be referred to the organization in question directly or through the Cyber Grand Challenge Program Manager.

WAIVER

The DARPA Cyber Grand Challenge Program Manager shall be the only authority for waiving the non-disclosure restrictions set forth in this agreement.
